Saline Point Result

The third exploration test (TDW 34 No.1) in the Saline Point Prospect reached total depth of 4,800 feet. The result of logging and core analysis showed that the prospective interval was too tight to produce commercial quantities of oil and the decision was made to plug and abandon the well.

"We are disappointed with the result," said Justin Pettett Pryme's Managing Director. "We will review our options for this project over the coming weeks."

Project Description

Pryme has a 26.96% Working Interest (20.22% Net Revenue Interest (NRI)) in the Saline Point project. Saline Point is located in the southern portion of Catahoula Lake in LaSalle Parish, Louisiana. The project is targeting in excess of 1 million barrels of oil and is located near the Catahoula Lake and South Catahoula Lake oil fields which to date have produced 24 million and 4 million barrels of oil, respectively.
